Service Theme: Called to be loved & to love

Paul's prayer is outstanding: And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge —that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. Jesus reveals to us God's love in a way we could not have dreamt of. John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. Now he says go and love like I have loved you and I have loved you with the Father's love. We are called to receive this love (and that can be easy said than done, but we are called to know that God does love us and to accept his love for us) and to love others in turn.
