Service Theme: Remembrance

Today we remember those who have died in the atrocities of war particularly as this year marks the 100th anniversaries of the Battle of Arras and the Battle of Passchendaele. We remember those who have sacrificed their lives for the common good. Within our worship today there are elements of recalling, reliving, reconciling, rededication and hope for the future.
