Today's Readings: Ezra 1 and John 1:43-51

*Service Theme: According to Plan
Welcome to this Service*

If you are new to this Church or a visitor please do make yourself known to us.

The Israelites were in Exile from their homeland, from their Temple which was the centre of their worship to God. God uses the Persian king Cyrus (the Persians had successfully invaded Babylon) to bring about his plan to restore his people etc their promised land. Not only that there is generosity shown (these peoples were enemies!). The call is to go and rebuild the Temple. Cyrus ordered the people where survivors remain to provide for their return. Not only that he returns what was taken by Nebuchadnezzar when he had brought the people into exile and sacked the Temple of its belongings. God's purposes achieved through those who were not his people. This was God's plan for his people. God moved Cyrus' here as he did that of many others (vs5). God's plans can be surprising - "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?"
