Fifth Sunday of Lent

Today's Readings: Isaiah 40:27-31 and 1 Peter 5:6-11

Service Theme: Receiving Fresh Strength

Welcome to this Service

If you are new to this Church or a visitor please do make yourself known to us.

These verses speak profoundly of the reality of our human existence, which is so often marked by wearing. The grind of daily life, of simply keeping going when we are exhausted, can be hard enough at the best of times, but even harder in the midst of a crisis. Isaiah says that even the young who are strong and full of energy get tired and worn down but God does not. The Lord is the God of eternity whose strength knows no limits. This is the God who seeks to comfort us and give us new strength. There is a danger that we can get caught up with our own concerns that we don't even notice the action and comfort of God. Those who wait on God, Isaiah tells us will find themselves transformed by God's own strength. Yes the devil (1 Peter 5:8) tries to dissuade us of this truth but we are reminded by Peter that it is the God of all grace who will retire us and make us strong.
